Who is eligible? Elementary (grades K-5), middle and high-school students.

What can I submit? Submit a piece of art for the Art Contest, or a poem or essay for the Poetry/Essay Contest—or enter both contests! Be creative! Share your vision of Peace and Unity in a picture, drawing or painting (any size format), or in a poem (up to 40 lines) or an essay (up to 300 words). What does peace and unity mean to you?

What prizes will be awarded? Cash prizes will be awarded. 1st Place- \$100.00, 2nd Place- \$50.00, 3rd Place- \$25.00. One each per category. All entries will receive a certificate of appreciation. Also, winning entries will be published in The Daily Journal.

Where do I submit my entry? Drop your entry to your after-school teacher. All entries must be received by Friday, May 22, 2009. Be sure to fill out the entry form below and submit it with your art, poem/essay.

When will the winners be announced? At the *A Time of Remembrance, A Time for Choice and Change Celebration* on Saturday, May 30, 2009 at the Cumberland County College from 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. (Everyone is encouraged to attend.)

Who will judge the entries? Members of the sponsoring organizations, including: Nehemiah Coalition, Tri-County Community Action Partnership, and representatives of area churches.
